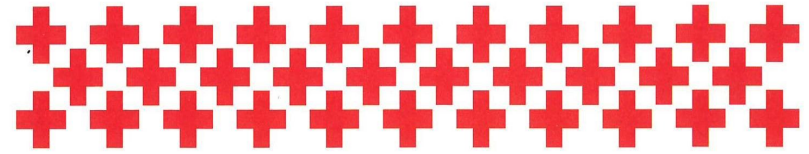
2024 Financial Reports have been sent out through email and there are copies available in the Information Center. There will also be copies available at the Congregational meeting on March 16.
